

UCF Associate Director of Sponsored Programs Earns 2023 Society of Research Administrators International Excellence Award

Terri Bigham, associate director of sponsored programs in the UCF Research Foundation, has been selected to receive the Society of Research Administrators International (SRAI) Excellence Award for 2023.
