

The Office of Research & Commercialization invites you to participate in an “NIH Boot Camp” at UCF on May 9th and 10th.

The purpose of the two day boot camp is to provide education and guidance on the National Institutes of Health’s (NIH) policies, organization, proposal submission, and proposal review process. The boot camp will be interactive and include presentations from an NIH program manager (tentative) and UCF NIH awardees. Topics covered during the workshop will include:

- Identifying the right NIH institute and funding mechanisms
- Creating a concept paper/research plan
- Developing various NIH proposal sections such as “Specific Aims”
- Researcher experiences with NIH funding mechanisms – R01, R15, R21 and the K-Series (Early Career)
- NIH review process

The boot camp will be held in the UCF Student Union on both days. Details on the agenda, presenters, and specific times for the presentations will follow in the next few weeks.
