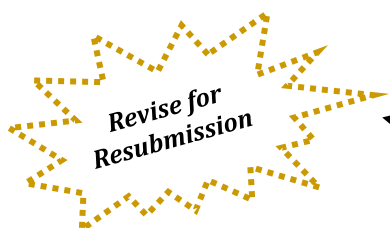


# REACTing to Faculty Research Needs at the UCF: Our unique approach to large proposal challenges!

To meet the research needs of this rapid growth while operating under a limited budget, the Research Development (RD) team recently launched REACT.
